## **GENERAL MUD PIT RULES FOR BG 4x4 FEST**

Release must be signed at registration. BG4x4Fest reserves the right to shut down mud pit at any time.

- 1. All vehicles will be operated in a safe manner while on the fairgrounds. Anyone operating in a dangerous manner will be asked to leave the fairgrounds immediately.
- 2. Every participant and spectator enters the in field at their own risk. BG 4x4 FEST, Wood County Fairgrounds, and Northwestern Ohio Tractor Pullers Association and its agents will not be held responsible for any injuries or property damage.
- 3. All participants, upon entry, release BG 4x4 FEST and its agents from all liability. Participants recognize that they will be held responsible for any injuries or damages occurring from the operation of their vehicle while on the fairgrounds.
- 4. All persons entering the mud pit will pay participation fees.
- 5. All State and Federal laws apply.
- 6. Must have a valid driver's license to enter the mud pit.
- 7. If you are asked to leave by any BG4x4Fest staff, you must leave immediately.
- 8. No Driver who is impaired by substances such as alcohol, marijuana, or other drugs will be allowed in the mud pit, drive sober.
- 9. No tearing up grounds.
- 10. Nothing on 2 wheels.
- 11. Must wear seat belts at all times.
- 12. No riding in the back of trucks in the mud pit, no exceptions. "No seat, No Rider"
- 13. Must wear an event wristband at all times to enter the mud pit. If found without one, a new one must be purchased to re-enter.
- 14. Anyone entering the mud pit must be 18 years of age and have a valid drivers license.
- 15. No chains or homemade contraptions for pulling out stuck rigs, there will be a tow truck onsite
- 16. No tickets will be refunded.
- 17. Violation of any rule can be ground for removal from the event.
