

GENERAL PULLING RULES FOR BG 4x4 FEST PULL

Release must be signed at registration. All participants receive a poker chip with pull distance.

1. Every participant and spectator enters the in field at their own risk. BG 4x4 FEST, Wood County Fairgrounds, Northwestern Ohio Tractor Pullers Association and its agents will not be held responsible for any injuries or property damage.
2. All participants, upon entry, release BG 4x4 FEST Wood County Fairgrounds, Northwestern Ohio Tractor Pullers Association and its agents from all liability. Participants recognize that they will be held responsible for any injuries or damages occurring from the operation of their vehicle while on the fairgrounds, including any damages to your vehicle.
3. All persons entering the sled pull will pay participation fees.
4. The Pull will be governed by the Sled Pull Committee of BG 4x4 FEST. The Pull Committee's decision will be final.
5. Any participant found to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol will not be permitted to pull, and will be removed.
6. All vehicles will be operated in a safe manner while on the fairgrounds. Anyone operating in a dangerous manner will be asked to leave the fairgrounds immediately.
7. The sled operator or the pull committee have the right to refuse to hook any vehicle they feel is not safe or fit to pull.
8. Violation of any rule can be grounds for removal.
9. Each vehicle will only be entered once per class (pending room in the class- you can buy back in).
10. Entries will close one class prior to the first hook of that class.
11. Each participant will hook in the order of draw or where placed by the pull committee. Any delays in hooking to the sled, or starting once hooked to the sled can be grounds for removal..
12. All drivers will be 18 years old or older with a valid drivers license.
13. No additional riders in any vehicle while on the pulling track.
14. No entries will be refunded after the start of the class.
